

Community mourns James Stone Balter

James Stone Balter, businessman and a long-time worker for charity groups, died August 29 of congestive heart-failure at the age of 71.

Balter fell ill while vacationing with his wife in the Greek Islands. He died in Izmir, Turkey.

Balter of Squirrel Hill was active within the community. He was the president of the James S. J. S. Balter



Balter Associates Business Consultants. Mr. Balter was also the CEO and President of Morris Paper Co., which was founded by his father.

Balter's charitable positions included Vice President-Treasurer of the Emma Kaufmann Camp, life trustee of the American Jewish Committee, and board member of the Jewish National Fund. Balter was also involved with many medical and psychological guilds, including the Mayview State Hospital League for Emotionally Disturbed Children as a past president, and vice president of the Cancer Guidance Institute.

Balter was a graduate of Shadyside Academy and the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.

He is survived by his wife, Bernita Buncher Balter; his four children Katherine Anthony of Chevy Chase, MD, Julia Balter of Portsmouth, NH, Connie Cantor of Pittsburgh and Daniel Balter of Marlboro, MA, his mother, Beatrice Balter
